In slaughterhouses and cutting plants, disinfectants are a daily occurrence. Certain disinfectants, however, can pose a risk to your health and that of your colleagues. They are called biocides. Be careful and take these tips into account in order to protect yourself properly.

Read the label

How do you know if you are working with a dangerous product? And what are the risks?

All important information is on the label.

So take a close look at it.
